Cincinnati Section IEEE Scholarship

Eligibility

To be eligible for a \$1000 tuition scholarship:

1. Student must be a member of the IEEE Student Chapter at their University.
2. Student must have completed a minimum of 30 semester credit hours, and not graduated. (i.e. for Sophomore, Juniors and Seniors)
3. Student must be enrolled in an ABET accredited bachelor of science program or equivalent.
4. Student must be majoring in Electrical Engineering or Technology, or Computer Engineering or Technology, or Computer Science.
5. Student must have a minimum of 3.0 out of 4.0 or B equivalent cumulative grade point average.
6. Student must be registered as a Full Time undergraduate student.
7. Student must be in good standing with their University.
8. An IEEE student chapter member may receive only one award.
9. A Cincinnati Section member may receive only one award.

3. The Scholarship Steering committee will review and confirm application eligibility.
4. Up to three yearly awards will be randomly selected from the pool of eligible applications.
5. If not awarded, a member is eligible to submit a new application the following year.
6. Award monies will be paid directly to the University Bursar with Student ID and Name.
7. The awardee must be registered with IEEE National as a student member.
