- 3. Student must be enrolled in an ABET accredited bachelor of science program or equivalent.
- 4. Student must be majoring in Electrical Engineering or Technology, or Computer Engineering or Technology, or Computer Science.
- 5. Student must have a minimum of 3.0 out of 4.0 or B equivalent cumulative grade point average.
- 6. Student must be registered as a Full Time undergraduate student.
- 7. Student must be in good standing with their University.
- 8. Any student who has previously received a Cincinnati Section IEEE Scholarship is ineligible to be awarded another Cincinnati Section IEEE Scholarship.
